# Patrick Carver name to NSCAA All-America Team for 2008

Patrick Carver from Emory University in Atlanta, Georgia was recently selected to the National Soccer Coaches Association of America All-America Team for 2008. The Senior from Springfield, Missouri is a repeat selection on the team as he also garnered honors in 2007. Carver who played High School Soccer at Parkview High School and for the Springfield Soccer Club is the first collegiate All-American from the club.

Carver, who shared the UAA Player of the Year honors with Ricky Griffin of Carnegie Mellon University (marking the first time the UAA has named co-Players of the Year), earned his second-straight UAA Player of the Year honor, becoming the first Emory men's soccer player to do so. This season, the senior has led the team with 13 goals and 33 points, including three goals and three assists in UAA matches, and moved into second place in school history with 129 career points and 50 points.

Carver joins Nate Micklos of Rochester (2004 and 2005) and Adam Hibshman of Carnegie Mellon University (2000, 2001, and 2002) as the only UAA players to earn multiple Player of the Year honors. The award marks the seventh time an Emory player has been named the UAA's Player of the Year. "It is a tremendous honor to be named an All-American again this year. It would not have been possible without the help of my coaches and teammates in Atlanta and here in Springfield. The award will be something I remember for years to come." said Patrick Carver. Last summer Carver captained the Springfield Soccer Club U23 Team during their inaugural season where the team finished undefeated.


## SSC 90/91 Boys # 1 in the Nation

This is quite an honor as you look at the list and see the major metropolitan markets that are also listed in the top 10. Springfield Soccer Club set out with a goal to make a mark on the State of Missouri, once that was accomplished; they set their sights on the Midwest Region and the Nation.

## Alumni Q&A: Luke Prater



## What was the biggest transition to college (not soccer wise)?

- I would say the toughest transition to college that isn't soccer related is the amount of work load you have to balance with school. Coming from a public high school, I wasn't really prepared for the work load I received from classes. I learned real quick though to keep my grades in order to play soccer.

#### What is the biggest difference between youth soccer and college soccer?

-The biggest difference between youth and college soccer is the pace of play. It is a lot faster and tougher than youth soccer. There aren't as many opportunities to hold onto the ball and show boat (without getting killed).

#### What is a typical week like in season?

-A typical week in soccer includes a full set of classes and practice everyday at 3:30-5:30. After that sometimes depending on the schedule of games, we have film at night after dinner. It is really busy and good management skills are needed to balance between soccer and school work and social play.

# Applying what you know now about college soccer is there anything you would have changed or focused more on during your youth soccer career?

-No I felt like I did the right thing when I was in youth soccer, and that was focusing on having fun. I wasn't exactly the best at getting my name out there for the colleges to recruit me, but I have landed up in the right place. I strongly believe that if someone focuses on having fun and doing it for the love of the game that they will end up where they are suppose to be.

## Best player/team you have gone against at college level?


I would have to say Santi or Miguel from Loras College. Both those guys have amazing ball skills and vision on the field. Not to mention they are blazing fast. Both all Americans as under classmen.

#### How did SSC prepare you for college (on/off the field)?

-SSC definitely prepared me for the fitness aspect of the game. SSC also prepared me for the competitive nature of college ball. Once you get to college it is a big competition to get playing time. SSC also prepared me to make friendships through soccer and special connections.

# Any advice for those starting the recruiting process and those who will begin college in the fall of 2007?

-Don't let the college search freak you out. Just focus on having fun playing with your teammates at the showcases and tournaments you have remaining. You play your best ball when you are having fun and relaxed. At the same time always think of ways you can constantly be improving your game whether it may be juggling or dribbling every day. Get out and do it.


